- REFUND OF ENTRIES: Nominations will only be refunded with a Doctor's or Vet certificate within 1 week of the event. 10% of the fee may be retained for administration costs, and the cattle levy fee of \$10
- SOUVENIR SHIRTS: Order forms are attached - please send with separate cheque to organizing secretary. All shirts MUST be pre-ordered. Orders are to be collected on arrival at the grounds.
- QUALIFICATIONS: As per each discipline.
- PRESENTATION: For presentation of awards at the conclusion of a State fixture it is the Team Managers responsibility to assemble all competitors, mounted and in full uniform, ribbon winners or not for the final parade. An unmounted assembly may be organized at the discretion of the Organizing Body in extenuating circumstances. *Request for special permission to leave must be made in writing by the Zone Team Manager and may be granted by the Judge in Chief and the Chief Steward in exceptional circumstances.*
- SUBSTITUTION: Mounts may be substituted before the commencement of the event upon presentation of a veterinary certificate or a written statement from the Club Chief Instructor. If such substitution is made, the replacement mount must be eligible within the terms of the PCAQ rules. NO substitution of rider is permitted under any circumstances.
- FIRST AID: St John's Ambulance will be in attendance at this event.
- SAFETY: Whilst an official gear check will be carried out, it is ultimately the responsibility of the competitor for the safety of their gear.

Team Managers Duties

YOUTH HANDLER GUIDELINES & JUDGING PROCEDURE

1. Youth Handler Classes are to be judged strictly on the handler's ability to show a horse in a led class. No consideration is to be given to the horse other than grooming and presentation. The horse is only a prop to show the ability of the handler.

2. The procedure for judging is as follows:

2.1. The horse and handler enter the ring at a brisk walk as directed by the Steward. The horse is to be led from the near side. The horse must walk at the same pace as the handler - moving in a brisk, alert manner.

2.2. When instructed to line-up, the handler must stand the horse squarely on all four feet and must present the horse in a position so as not to hinder the Judge's view of the horse at any time.

2.3. The Judge will then call upon individual handlers to present their horses, and parade to his/her request. When turning, it must be to the right to give the Judge full view of the horse. Know where the Judge is at all times, so as not to obstruct his/her view of the horse.

2.4. The handler must always keep position in the line and allow reasonable space between the horses on either side. If asked to change position in the line, the horse must be backed out of the line and approach the new position from behind.

2.5. The handler must be alert and courteous and respond quickly to instructions from the Judge or Steward.

3. Unsportsmanlike behaviour may cause elimination.

4. This event will be judged on the following guidelines:

4.1. The horse is to be clean and well presented. No consideration will be given to the horse's conformation and type.

4.2. The horse must be shown in a bridle that is well fitted, neat and clean. A show whip is permitted and must not exceed 1 metre in length.

4.3. The handler is to be well presented.

4.4. Showmanship to be judged on the handler's ability to show his/her horse.

5. In order to gain maximum points, avoid the following:

5.1. Failure to recognise and correct faults of the horse's position.

5.2. Kicking, hitting or having leg contact with the horse.

5.3. Talking with other contestants.

5.4. Failure of the horse to lead properly.

5.5. Failure to stop the horse before turning when at a walk or trot.

5.6. Failure to back the horse when necessary.

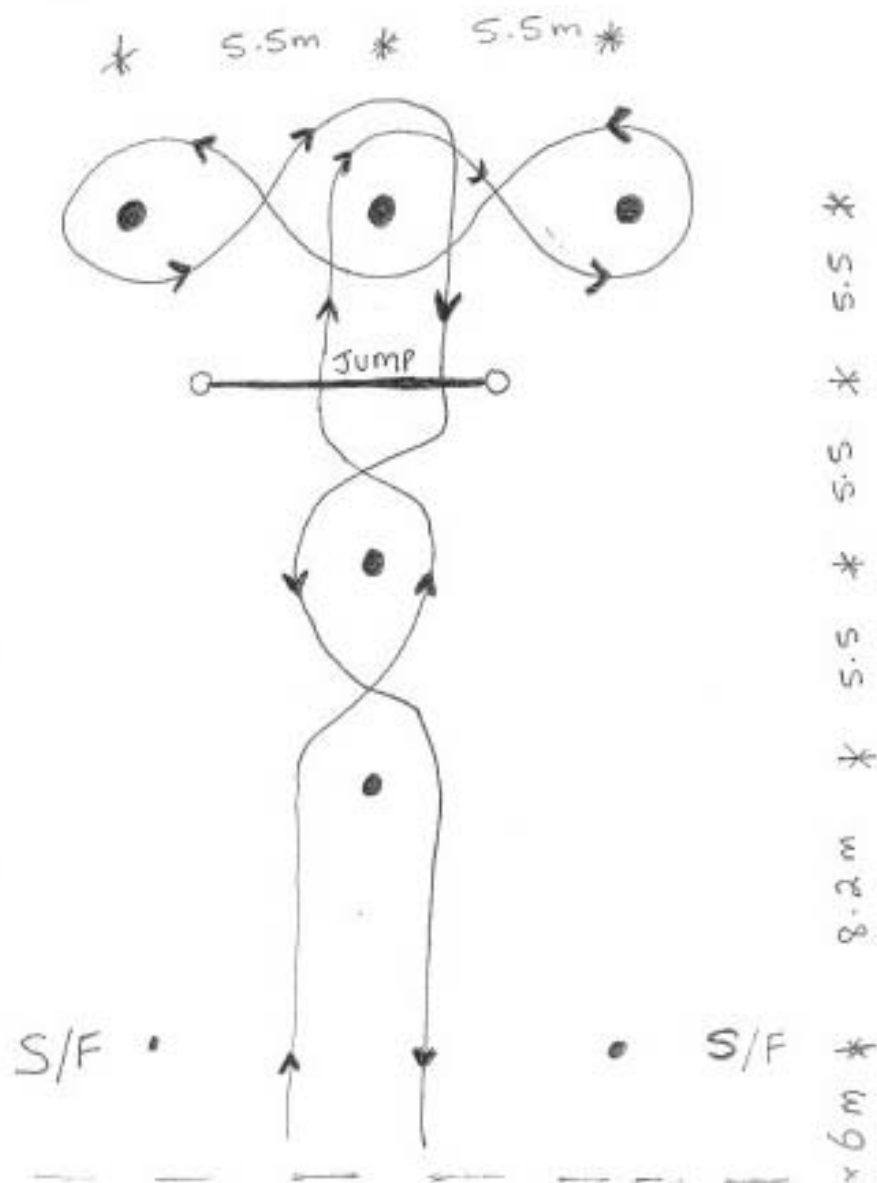
5.7. Loud voice commands to the horse.

5.8. Turning the horse in the wrong direction.

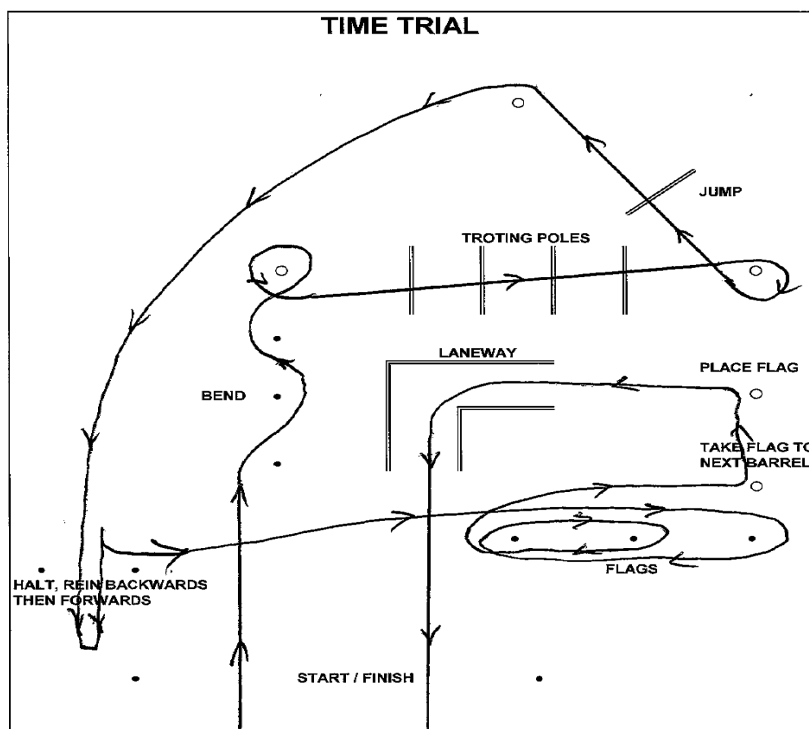
5.9. Blocking the Judge's view of the horse.

5.10. Causing the Judge to move to avoid being bumped or stepped on.

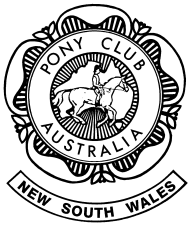

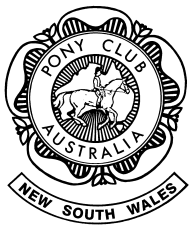

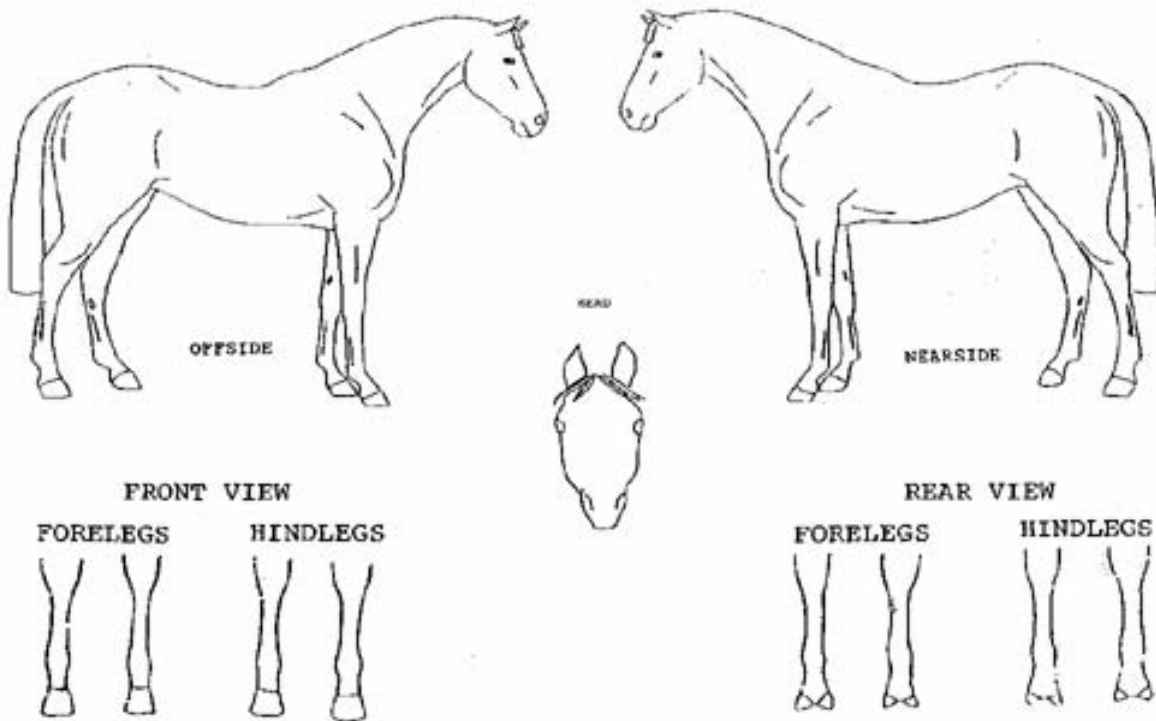
